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## PROSPECTUS FOR NRI ADMISSION FOR MBBS/ BDS/ B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Pharm. Courses 2009-10

### I. a. Introduction

The Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram is a Self Financing Institution which started functioning in 1995. Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram admits students for Management seats for various courses – MBBS, BDS, B.Sc. Nursing and B.Pharm – for 35% of its total seats in the management quota and 15% of seats in the NRI quota during the academic year 2009-10, as per the rules and regulations framed by the Government of Kerala for admission to management seats in Self Financing Colleges.

- b. This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations for selection and admission to the seats to be filled by the management.
- c. This Prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the management.
- d. Categorisation of seats:-

#### **Total Seats:-**

MBBS	-	100
BDS	-	60
B.Sc. Nursing	-	50
B. Pharm	-	40

The seats available for admission to the first year are mainly categorized as:-

1. Seats to be filled by the Government from the list of CEE, Kerala (50%)
2. NRI Seats to be filled by the management for students who are dependents of Non-Resident Indians (15%).

### II. **Criteria of Eligibility for Admission:-**

#### a. MBBS/BDS/BSc. Nursing/B-Pharm

Candidates must be citizens of India who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by the

Universities in the State of Kerala. Candidates should have secured an aggregate of not less than 50% marks in the optional subjects and 50% for Biology.

- b. For admission to B.Pharm course candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of Kerala or examination recognized as equivalent thereto with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology / Mathematics / Biotechnology / Computer Science put together are eligible.
- c. Candidates who have passed the BSc. Degree examination (3 year course) with Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany or Biotechnology as main and any one or two of the above subjects as subsidiaries, with 50% marks or main and subsidiaries taken together, subject to conditions that they have passed Pre-degree/Higher Secondary examination or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects are eligible for admission to MBBS, BDS, and B.Sc. Nursing Courses.
- d. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from authorities other than the State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and the equivalency of the qualifying examination.

### III. Age:-

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2009. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.

### IV.

<b>NRI QUOTA</b>
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**Definition:** NRI seats are defined as those seats set apart for the Son/Daughter, Brother/Sister, Niece/Nephew, First cousin or dependant of non-resident Indian citizen or in their absence foreign citizens of Kerala origin (PKO) or in their absence NRI's who are non-keralites.

**Selection Procedure:** Their merit will be decided on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations and by a personal interview.

#### **Allocation of Seats:**

- i. **The** allotment in the NRI Quota for various courses will be as follows  
MBBS – 15 Seats, BDS – 9 Seats, BSc. Nursing – 8 Seats, B-Pharm – 6 Seats.
- ii. NRI Candidates seeking admission to ACME should be enclose a copy of one of the following documents to prove the NRI status of his/her parent and declaration of the NRI in the

prescribed form to establish his/her relationship with the candidates.

- a. Attested copy of the relevant pages of the Passport containing Visa details.
- b. Attested copy of the Employment Certificate and relevant pages of the Certificate.
- c. Certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank stating that he/she is Non-Resident Indian holding a NRI account other than a Zero balance account.

#### **V. How to apply:-**

##### **a. Application Forms:**

Application forms will be available from the office of the Director, ACME Pariyaram on all working days from 10 A.M. to 5. P.M. from 11-05-2009 onwards.

##### **b. Cost of application forms:**

The cost of application form for MBBS and BDS will be Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) and Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) for B.Sc. Nursing and B.Pharm courses

***Download and print the application form along with a D.D of worth Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) for MBBS and BDS and Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) for B.Sc. Nursing and B.Pharm course in favour of Director, Academy of Medical Sciences payable at KANNUR***

##### **c. Certificates/documents to be produced along with the filled application form.**

1. Attested copy of the mark list of qualifying examination
2. A self addressed envelope (12 X 25 cms size) with Indian Postal stamps worth Rs.5/- affixed thereon.
3. Attested copies of relevant page of School records namely SSLC/ISC/CBSE certificate showing the date of birth should be furnished along with the application as proof of age.

##### **d. The filled in application forms with all the required certificates/documents shall be submitted to the **Director, Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur** on or before **11-06-09, 5 p.m.****

#### **VI. Procedure of Selection:-**

- a. 50% of the seats will be filled by the Government of Kerala from the list prepared by the CEE, Kerala.
- b. 35% of the seats to be filled by the management as per the above criteria.

- c. The management shall be entitled to fill up the remaining 15% seats by students who are dependents of Non Resident Indians.

**VII. Fees:-**

Fees structure will be as per the norms framed by the Government of Kerala.

**VIII. Special features:-**

- a. All students who get selected should get themselves vaccinated against hepatitis before admission. A certificate to the effect will be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.
- b. If any candidate discontinues/leaves the Institution within a period of 15 days before the closing of admission in the first year or discontinues/leaves the Institution in the subsequent years, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the remaining years i.e. fees for the whole course. In such cases Transfer Certificate and other certificates will be issued only after the payment of the fees for the remaining years are also made.
- c. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the College Campus. An efficient anti-ragging committee is constituted with the participation of students, staff members and parents.
